2016**

 - a. The CDD has no plans to replace the public facilities within the next ten years.

- 4. Provide the anticipated time the construction, improvement or expansion of each facility will be completed.** (Insert currently anticipated completion of the project).
 - a. Master Improvements as listed on Page #3 - #8 of the District Engineers Report shall be completed by Fiscal Year 2024
